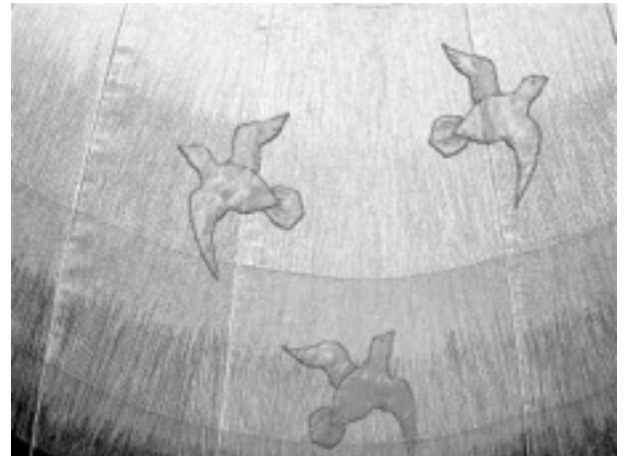

# Notices for 15<sup>th</sup> October 2017

**Prayer** There is a 'Prayer Box' at the back of church for you to put any prayer requests that you have. There are some pieces of paper to write your prayer request on and to indicate whether you want just the intercessor group to know or whether you would like this mentioned in the church.

**Wholeness Ministry** is available after the morning service to pray for your own or others' needs. Please make your way to the right side of the Church where people will be waiting to pray with you.

**Food Bank** Please continue to help provide for a Food Bank - box in foyer each Sunday. The Food Bank particularly would like UHT milk, and 500g bags of sugar (not larger) though all food is greatly appreciated.

**New Kitchen** The work of building a new kitchen continues. Over three quarters of the budget cost has been raised so far. We still need to raise approximately £5,000 to reach the budget cost of £63000. Any money - give to Mike please clearly labelled "Kitchen". Permissions have all been granted. We have received two lots of £5,000 grants and a grant of £1,000. The stage has gone and the new floor is in. Arthur and Dave have started on the electrical work and the kitchen fitter has started on the making of the kitchen furniture. Some cost trimming can occur but any further donations would be **very welcome - please mark clearly "Kitchen"**. Hopefully finished in time for the Autumn Fair! See Pedr or Dave after the service to have a look at progress so far.

**Firewood** - £1 a bag (all the old floorboards) for sale - all proceeds to the kitchen fund - just 20 bags left.
